Through three quarters of 2019, Sales tax is down \$234 thousand compared to the same period of 2018. This accounts for approximately a 1% decline in annual sales taxes.

Construction related sales taxes are up \$285 thousand year-to-date, with the third quarter coming in \$281 thousand or 66% greater than the third quarter of 2018.

All Other Industries are down \$518 thousand, which accounts for a 3% decline. Although the third quarter was \$567k down compared to the prior year, the third quarter of 2018 included approximately \$380 thousand of one-time sales taxes.



The 2019 budget for sales taxes is \$19.894 million, which is nearly equal to total collections for 2018. Through the third quarter of 2019 sales tax collections are \$234 thousand less than the allocated annual budget.



The chart above compares the prior year-to-date totals to the current year-to-date totals for the eight major categories of sales tax.

The Construction sector is the largest increase year-to-date, highlighting a strong third quarter for that sector. Automotive sales taxes have the largest year-to-date decline; this is attributed to a single taxpayer with approximately \$246 thousand less in sales taxes this year compared to the prior year.
