

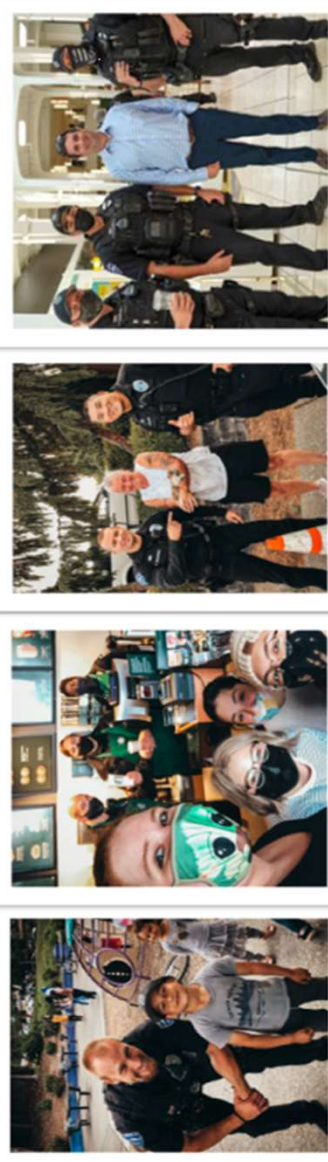

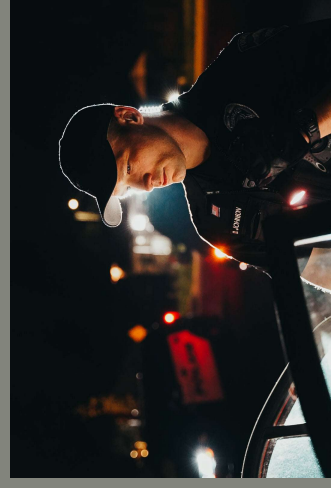
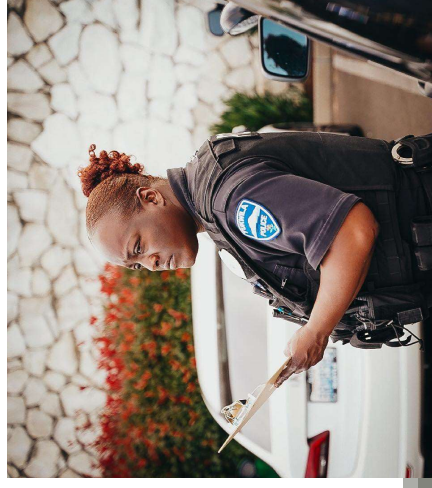
2021 HIGHLIGHTS

- 1,471 cases completed via online reporting



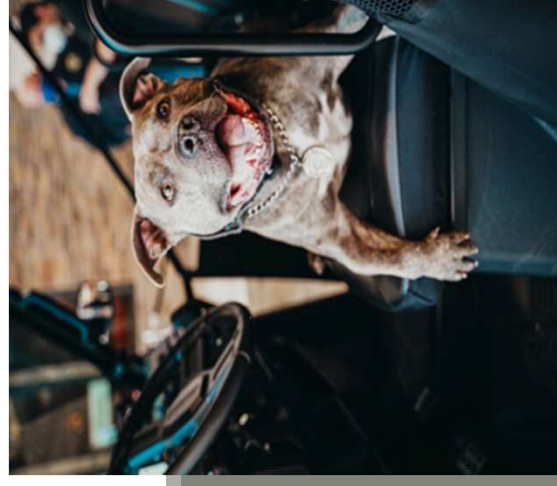
SUPPORT OPERATIONS DIVISION

- Processed 3,489 records requests
 - 2,117 hours approximately spent on records request
- Processed 3,234 items of evidence and property
- Processed 6,909 in-person reports and 1,471 online police reports
- 2003 and 2004 case files were digitized
- Administered 185 CPL, 603 firearm transfers, 3 dealer licenses

- Responded to 2 homicide investigations
- Increased investigations in robberies, aggravated assaults, auto theft, larceny cases
- Narcotics Detection K9 Team assisted with seizures of cash and drugs
- Narcotics and human trafficking investigations

- Valley Narcotics Enforcement Team partnership



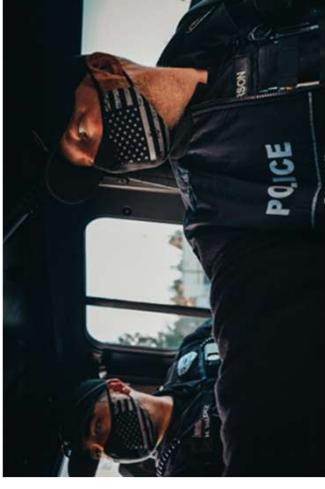
PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS DIVISION
