NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed bids will be received by the City of Tukwila, Washington at the Office of the City Clerk, at Tukwila City Hall, 6200 Southcenter Boulevard, Tukwila, Washington 98188, up to the hour of **9:30 a.m. on Wednesday , February 7, 2024**. Bids will be opened and publicly read aloud at 10:00 a.m on the same day.

Bids can be mailed to Tukwila City Hall and must be received by 9:30 a.m. the day the bids are due OR dropped off on Wednesday morning. A box will be located outside the double doors at Tukwila City Hall near the flagpole on the day of the bid opening from 8:30 to 9:30 a.m. Bids will be picked up, with the last pickup being at exactly 9:31 a.m. on **Wednesday, February 7, 2024** based on the Atomic Clock in the City's Clerk's Office. The work to be performed within **35** working days from the date of Notice to Proceed consists of furnishing all materials, equipment, tools, labor, and other work or items incidental thereto for:

A public trail around the newly constructed Chinook Wind Mitigation Project along the Duwamish River in Tukwila. Work generally includes the construction and installation of a small trailhead parking area, storm drainage, crushed rock paths, park furnishings, signage, paving, planting and irrigation.

Proposals received later than the submittal deadline will not be accepted. The City will not be liable for delays in delivery of proposals due to handling by the U.S. Postal Service or any other type of delivery service. Faxed or emailed submittals will not be accepted.

Informational copies of any available maps, plans, specifications, and subsurface information are on file for inspection in the office of the Tukwila City Engineer, at the Public Works Department.

All bid proposals shall be submitted according to the Information for Bidders and be accompanied by a bid proposal deposit in the form of a cash deposit, certified or cashier's check, postal money order, or surety bond made payable to the City of Tukwila, for a sum not less than five percent (5%) of the amount of such bid, including sales tax. Should the successful bidder fail to enter such contract and furnish satisfactory payment and performance bonds within the time stated in the specifications, the bid deposit/bond shall be forfeited to the City of Tukwila.

The City of Tukwila hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contracts entered pursuant to this advertisement, minority business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, sex or national origin in consideration for an award.
