## 3. Contract Specifications:

Revise the first paragraph of 1-08.0(2) to state the following:

(Special Provision) New

Typical work hours for the non-limited access planing and paving activities within each site are restricted to the hours shown below.

8-hour period between 7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.

Typical work hours for the limited access planing and paving activities shall conform to the construction permit between WSDOT and the City of Tukwila. The contractor shall anticipate work hours for contract work within limited access outside the typical 8-hour period established herein.

## Add a third paragraph to 1-08.4 Notice to Proceed and Prosecution of Work

Contract work shall not proceed within WSDOT Limited Access until the final construction permit is granted to the City of Tukwila and furnished to the Contractor.

## 4. Plan Sheets:

Add sheet 39, Detour for 518 off ramp left turn closure, at the end of the plan set. The total sheet count is now 39.


