

City of Tukwila Business License Fee Open House

The City is completing the 2019/2020 budget.

Historically, the City has relied heavily on sales tax revenue to account for around a third of its revenue. Due to evolving buying behaviors and changes in how sales taxes is credited to cities, the City has seen a flattening of sales tax revenue, and projects a \$3 million shortfall for the 2019-2020 biennium. The City has already reduced spending by 3% for most departments, and 1.5% each for Police and Fire. Nearly 60% of the City's revenue supports the critical public safety functions of Police, Fire, and Public Works. **In order to avoid reductions to these critical public safety services, the City is considering increasing business license fees to offset the loss of sales tax revenue.**
