## Accepted:

### ✓ ELECTRONICS

PCs, monitors, laptops, printers, scanners, desktop copiers, televisions, stereos, VCRs, radios, and cellular phones. **Limit 3 each per item.**

### ✓ SCRAP METAL

Limit 2 ft. x 2 ft. x 2 ft. 35 lbs.

### ✓ HOUSEHOLD APPLIANCES ACCEPTED INCLUDING:

Stoves, microwaves, toaster ovens, washers, dryers, dishwashers, freezers, refrigerators, air conditioners and water heaters.

**In the interest of safety, take doors off all large appliances. Limit 3 each per item.**

### ✓ FURNITURE

Mattresses, box springs (all sizes), chairs, loveseats, sofas (NO sofa beds), dressers, patio furniture, other large furniture.

### ✓ MISCELLANEOUS

- Flattened cardboard (NO plastic or wax coating)
- Lawn mowers (must be free of fuel and oil)
- Yard waste

## Not Accepted:

### ✗ AUTOMOTIVE WASTE

All automotive fluids, car batteries, running gears, and automotive body parts.

### ✗ HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

Any products with Danger, Poison, Caution or Warning on the label or products containing mercury, thermometers, thermostats, fluorescent bulbs and tubes.
